A G R E E M E N T.

THIS MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT by and between Cedar City, a Corporation by its Public Library and Gymnasium Board as first party and Francis Dalton, as second party:

WITNESSETH: That the first party hereby employs the second party to Teach the Public Gymnasium established by said first party, for the term of eight or more months of four weeks of five days each (legal holidays falling on regular days for gymnasium work to be counted as gymnasium days) beginning September 1911, and agrees to pay therefor the sum of One hundred and fifty (150) Dollars, divided into equal monthly payments; payments to be made at the first regular meeting of the City Council after the end of each month.

IN CONSIDERATION of said employment it is agreed that the entire time and best efforts of said second party be given for eight hours each week upon the terms and price above named, in accordance with and subject to such rules and regulations as have been made or may be made by said first party or the Library and Gymnasium Board of Cedar City.

This contract may be terminated by the first party at any time without ~~xxxx~~ previous notice for misconduct, insubordination, incompetence or persistent violations of the rules and regulations of the first party or its Gymnasium Board, but unless so terminated shall continue in force until the close of the District School term in 1912.

The second party agrees to attend the Summer School of the University of Utah which commences on June 12th, 1911.
