which seemed high. also fireplace.

Miss Brotbank described an ideal childrens  
library.

Suggested making it home like, use fireplace,  
walls that reflect light, indirect lighting, shelving  
low. tables rectangular two or 3 heights, all cloth covered.

It was decided to Calceamine cream coloring light tan  
walls and paint the pipes.

Sister Station (Pres. of Utah state Library Assoc.) ask  
for cooperation on inviting the convention to  
convene in Cedar City. Voted in assent Mrs. Station we

would be heartily in favor of convention and  
would do all we could to support it. Also as Chamber

of Commerce to transport convention to Cedar Breaks  
Lib Board would serve a luncheon.
