May 12, 1930.

The Library board met in the city office with Mayor Branger presiding.

Those present were, Mayor Branger, Allie Kull, Leland Bettensen, Sadie Thorley, Lillian Corry, Evelyn Skelton, and Mrs E. C. Staton.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read by Mrs Skelton and approved by board.

Mrs Staton came to give a voluntary report on the library. She reported 1535 books in childrens library and discussed conditions. She brought for the library the Cane Co. news, Piquan Times and other surrounding county papers from her personal money. The question was ask by Mayor Branger "Is there complete co-operation between the childrens library and the senior library?" It was answered affirmatively. Mrs. Staton was excused.

Mayor Branger reported estimate of cost to repair two steps in front of library, repair cornice at back and gutter. The estimate made by Morone Perry was \$210. two hundred and ten dollars. It was also mentioned that the front cornice needed repairing and that we needed screens and awnings for the front windows.

Mrs Kull motioned we have steps fixed immediately. It was seconded by Mrs Corry and approved by board.

Ada Skelton's report of the amount of work she averaged per day was read. The average was three hours and 15 minutes.

Mrs Thorley moved we pay Ada Skelton \$20 per month instead of \$10. Seconded by Mrs Corry and approved by the board. (Bills were read & approved)

Mr. Bettensen moved we adjourn until June

June 19, 1930

Mayor Granger to-gether with Evelyn Webster

the assessed valuation of one million seven
hundred thousand dollars. which should
bring to library \$3400.

Mrs Knell moved we accept recommendation

A motion was made by Mrs. ~~Barlow~~ that the lady put in to take Mrs Middletons place as Childrens librarian, be appointed as assistant librarian. Sec. Mrs Knell. unanimous.

A motion by Mrs Thorley that we grant Mrs Middleton a leave of absence for six months beginning Aug 1st 1930 and ending Jan 31, 1931. was sec by _____ carried

Mayor Granger recommended we appoint Mrs Lillian Corry to act as assistant librarian in Mrs Middletons absence.

Mr Bettensen moved that the board appoint Mrs Lillian Corry as assistant librarian and supervisor of Childrens library to take place Aug 1st 1930 - Jan 31, 1931. Sec. Mrs Knell unanimous.

Committee that was appointed to investigate the proposition of making a room for city office in Childrens library reported it was possible.

Mr Bettensen motioned we rent the space to the city for \$25. per month, the city to put in the partition and hold out the rent until it is paid for, the said office and Childrens library to be used only for city council meetings. Sec. By Mrs Knell. passed.
