Jan.

The Cedar City public library board meet in the City office in Jan at 7:30. Present, City manager Leland Perry acting chairman, Mr. Betensen, Mr. Barlow Mrs. Skelton.

Minutes were read and approved. A letter from H. O. Larson, was read by Mr. Perry. Concerning the fire insurance for the library Mr. Hooper (June) and Mr. Marjess Dalley was also considered.

A motion ^{was} made by Mr. Betensen that we accept the fire insurance policy (New England) issued by H. O. Larson which would cost \$64.80. Motion sec. by Mr. Barlow accepted.

Moved we make a study of the needs of additional insurance for the library, to be considered as possible after the full board could be gotten together. Motion made by Mr. Barlow sec. Betensen.

Mr. Betensen moved we accept the bills as read by Mr. Perry. Sec. Mr. Barlow. A motion accepted for adjournment.

Feb. 13 — 1933.

Cedar City public library board meet in the children library.

Present, Mr. Barlow, Betensen & Mrs. Skelton, Skelton & Corry.

Mr. Barlow was voted in as acting chairman.

Minutes were read and accepted. Mrs. Corry read a report of requirements of the library.

A motion was made by Mr. Betensen,

That we authorize Mrs Corry to order twelve magazine file case and 1 index file case. Sec. Mrs Thorley Unanimous.

Mrs Thorley motioned we authorize Mrs Corry to clean her type writer and buy a ribbon at our expense.

Mrs Thorley moved we charge \$1:00 ^{for books} for all non tax payers besides having the individual have tax payers sign with them. The \$1.00 will be retained after two months use of the library. Sec Mr. Betensen. Motion Carried

Motion that we pay the \$150 bill for books Mrs Corry bought also buy a brush brush. Motion made by Webster Sec Betensen Carried.

Mrs Webster made a motion that Mr Barlow, Mrs Corry, Webster act as a committee to investigate Gen. Hardy's connections with the library.

Betensen made a motion we accept the bills as read by Mr. Barlow. Motion for adjournment.

Mar - 22 - 1933.

Cedar City public library board met in the city office at 8:00 P.M.

Present Mayor Granger, Mr Barlow Betensen Mrs Thorley Knell, Webster Corry.

Minutes were read and approved. A motion was made by Mr Barlow that the funds for members of the board will not be renewed except for the secretary and treasurer.

Bills ~~were read~~ amounting to \$108.03 were read by Mayor Granger. A motion to approve the bills was made by Mr Betensen see Mr Barlow, accepted.

A motion made by Barlow that we the requisition for \$2.50 envelope Sec Knell. accepted

a motion made by Thorley that we authorized the librarian to secure help amounting to \$3.50 per month.

May 8 — 1933

Cedar City public library board meet in the city office at 8:00 P.M.

Present — Mayor Granger, Knell, Thorley, Webster.

Minutes were read and approved.

Mayor Granger read all bills. Mrs Knell made a motion that we accept them as Thorley — accepted.

Mrs Thorley made a motion that we pay Ellen Dix ten dollars per month. Sec Mrs Knell. unanimous.

A motion was called for adjournment.

June 19 — 1933.

The Cedar City public library board meet in the city office June 19, at 8:00 P.M.

Present — Mayor Granger Mrs Knell, Thorley, Corry & Webster & Mr. Betensen.

Minutes were read and approved. Bills amounting to \$46.50 were read by Mayor Granger.

Mrs Knell moved we accept all bills as Thorley unanimous.

Resolution was read by Mrs Corry which would cost approximately \$10.00. A motion we approve that was made by Mrs Thorley sec. Betensen. Carried.

A motion was called for adjournment.

Aug 13 - 1933.

The Cedar City public library board meet in the city office at 8:00 p.m.

Present Mayor Granger, Mrs Knell, Mr Betensen, Skebete.

Minutes of last meeting were read and approved.

All accumulated bills were read by Mayor Granger.

Mr. Betensen made a motion that we accept the bills and order the sec & treas to pay them. Sec Knell, ~~un~~ unanimous.

Motion called for adjournment.

Sept 11 - 1933

The library board met in the city office at 8:00 P.M.

Present Mayor Granger Mrs Knell, Belene, N. J. Barlow and Mr Skebete.

Minutes were read and approved.

Lillian Cory came and presented her bills and the library problems.

Mayor Granger suggested that the book committee handle the magazine problem and reorder the magazines for next year.

A motion was made by Mr. Betensen that the book committee order twenty books for the rental shelf - Sec Knell. Carried.

Mr. Barlow moved that we get bids from Magazine Co's and that the book committee pass on the bids from the various companies. Sec Knell. Carried.

Mr. Barlow moved we send for a book binder, to mend all books needing mending. Sec. Betensen. Carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Barlow that we ask Mr. Hendricks to recommend Cedar students to help Mrs Cory in the
