- June 18

The Cedar City public library ^{board} meet in the Hunter Hardware store for their first meeting at 3:00 P.M. with Mayor Hunter taking charge.

Present Mayor Hunter, Mrs. Allie C. Knell, Mrs. Grace Mc Mullen, Mrs. DeWitt.

Minutes were read and approved.

Mayor Hunter introduced and announced the new board members, Mrs. Grace Mc Mullen, Mr. Parley Dally and Mrs. Myrtle Janson.

A few library problems were discussed but no action was taken on them.

The bills due since the first of the year were read. Mrs. Knell made a motion we approve them. See Mrs. Mc Mullen. Passed.

A motion was called for adjournment.

Aug - 6 - 1934

The Cedar City public library board meet in the city office at 8:00 P.M.

Present Mayor Hunter, Mrs. Knell, Mrs. Mc Mullen, Mr. Dally, Mrs. Coery and Mrs. DeWitt.

Minutes were read and approved.

A motion was made by Mrs. Mc Mullen that we raise all employees \$5 per month except Allen Dix and pay the sec. and treasurer five dollars per month. See by Mrs. Knell. Unanimous.

A motion was made by Mrs. Knell that we pay Allen Dix \$1.50 per hour for all additional work over her 2 1/2 hours per day.

A motion was made by Mrs Knell that Mr. Hunter select a typewriter while in Salt Lake City which is rebuilt and buy it. Sec Mrs McMullen.

Mrs Knell made a motion that Mr Parley Dalley be authorized to go over the library and see what repairs were needed and report at the next meeting. Sec Mrs McMullen.

A list of books amounting to approximately \$200.00 in cost were presented by Mrs Corry, who ask that they be added to the library. After going over them carefully a motion was made by Mrs McMullen that we accept this book list and authorized Mrs Corry to send for them. Sec Mrs Knell. Carried.

Mr Hunter presented the bills for approval. Mrs Knell made a motion we accept them. Sec Mrs McMullen. Passed.

Sept-28 - 1934.

The Cedar City library board meet in the city office at 7:30 P.M.

Present - Mayor Hunter, Mrs Knell, McMullen, Mrs Janson, Mr Dalley, Mrs Corry, Mrs Madson and Mrs Skelton. Minutes were read and approved.

Mayor Hunter ask Mrs Corry to present her bills, which she did, discussing them.

Mrs Knell made a motion we approve the bills and authorize the treasurer to pay them. Sec Mrs Janson. Passed.

A motion by Mrs Janson was made to give \$50.00 fifty dollars to the Childrens library for books, with a committee to help select the books. Sec Mr Dalley.

Mayor Hunter appointed Mrs Janson, Mrs Knell and Mrs Madsen to select and buy the books for the Childrens library.

A motion was made ^{by Mrs Knell that} Mr. Dalley investigate the architectural needs of the library building and report at the next meeting.

Mayor Hunter granted Mrs Corry a leave of absence to go to Salt Lake City for an operation. Her check was to be paid as usual and she was to pay her employees.

The book committee was appointed to go over the magazines with Mrs Corry after she had written to several magazine agencies to obtain the best prices, and order them for the year.

A motion for adjournment was accepted.

Nov. 22 - 1934

The Cedar City library board met in the city office. Mrs Stebiter was not present.

Mrs McMullin moved that the bills be approved; seconded by Mrs Janson. The motion carried.

Fines were discussed. It was decided 5¢ a day per book is not too much to charge for past due books. The mayor will send a man out to collect books at the homes that are far past due.

It was agreed to send flowers to Mrs Lillian Corry at the L. D. S. hospital. Mrs Madsen turned into Mr Hunter thirty five dollars of fine money

\$1.69 was turned in also on a book
that had been lost to Mr Hunter.
a motion was called for adjournment.
