The Cedar City public library board met in the city office at 7:30 P.M.

Present - Mayor Hunter, Mrs Janson, Mrs McMullen, Mr Dalley & Evelyn Schubert.

Minutes were read and approved. Mrs. Bert Smith met with the library board to discuss the possibility of using the childrens library for a private kindergarten visit the mornings and before 3:00 p.m. in the afternoon. It was carefully discussed with her and then she was dismissed.

Mrs Janson made a motion that we could not rent a public institution for a private enterprise, and also that we could not afford to subject the books to the little people and have no member of the library force present. Sec. Mr Dalley. motion passed.

The bills were read and a motion was made by Mr. Dalley to accept all bills except the one from the Iron Co. Record. That was to be investigated by Mrs. Madson before it was paid. Sec. Mrs. Janson, carried. motion ^{was} made for adjournment.

Mar 25

The Cedar City public library board met in the city office at 7:30 P.M.

Present - Mayor Hunter, Mrs Knell, Mrs McMullen, Mrs Corry and Mrs Schubert. Mr. Dalley.

Minutes were dispensed with. The mayor discussed the proposition of dividing the county tax money allotted to the libraries, fifty, fifty

with Parowan.

Because Cedar City public library circulates to four fifths of the county and Parowan to one fifth, the board flatly voted no to the proposition.

Bills were read by Mayor Hunter. Mrs Knell made a motion the bills be approved and ordered paid by treasurer. Sec Mrs Janson. Carried.

Mrs. McMullen made a motion we raise Ellen Dixes salary to \$20 per hour. Sec Mrs Knell. Motion Carried.

Mr Dally made a motion that Mrs. Madson have a two weeks vacation with pay. Sec Mrs McMullen motion carried. Motion called for adjournment.

June 19

The Cedar City library board met in the City office at 8:00 P. M.

Present - Mayor Hunter, Mrs Janson, Mrs McMullen, Mrs Knell, Mr Dally & Webster.

Minutes were read and approved.

A discussion on the F. C. R. A. in connection with a library project was led by Mayor Hunter.

A motion was made by Mrs Janson that the board authorize the secretary to pay the insurance on the F. C. R. A. project for the Cedar City library after Mr Dally approves the project. Sec Mr. Dally. Carried.

The project is to amount to approximately \$700.00

Mrs. Corry presented the bills.

Mrs McMullen made a motion to approve all bills and authorize the treasurer to pay them. Sec Mrs Janson. Motion carried. A motion was made for adjournment.

Aug. 24, 1935

The Cedar City public library board met in the City office at 8:30 P.M.
Present- Mayor Hunter, Mr. Dalley, Mrs. Corry Mrs. Knell & Mrs. Webster Mrs. McMullen.
Minutes were read and approved.

Mr. Dalley made the report on the cost of remodeling the library roof or putting a new one on.

Mr. Dalley reports it will cost \$14,65.78 for materials for a new roof with \$350.00 cost for labor to be provided by the P. D.

Mrs. McMullen made a motion that Mr. Dalley be authorized to present the estimates to Mr. Thompson and have a project drawn under the P. D., ready to present to the City Council Sec. Mrs. Knell. Carried.

Mrs. Corry presented the bills. Mr. Dalley made a motion we accept them as read and order paid. Sec. by Mrs. Knell. Carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Dalley that Mrs. Corry was to be raised \$2.50 per month and Mrs. Madson \$10.00 per month. Mrs. Madson was to put in two more additional hours each day Mrs. Corry and Mrs. Madson are to supervise the P. D. work of cleaning, varnishing, ~~and~~ the books and recataloguing some of them. Minutes were read and approved. Mr. Dalley reported that the project for the roof with the P. S. A. was all completed and everything was waiting for the Governor to approve it.

Bills were read. Mrs Janson made a motion the board approve them.

Mrs Madison came to discuss her salary. It was decided she should watch it carefully for one month and then the board should decide on her salary.

Mrs Corry was authorized to accept the lowest bid on the magazines. A motion was called for adjournment.

and Mrs Mc Mullen to buy one
dozen library chairs for the senior
library providing we have money
