Mayor Hunter discussed a proposition  
made by Mr. Sprinkel (Roof Contractor)  
to furnish the material and repair  
the roof of the library so it would not  
leak for \$40.00.

Mr. Dalley moved we accept the  
proposition of Mr. Sprinkel to repair  
all leaks in the roof for \$40.00 paying  
him \$20.00 after the job is completed  
and \$20.00 after the first heavy storm.  
Sec. Mrs. Knell. Motion carried.

Mrs. Knell made a motion that  
all fine money be collected and  
a check be made to cover petty funds

for running the library. See Mrs Janson  
motion carried.

Mrs Corry gave a very interesting report  
of her trip to California and her  
experiences in the large libraries  
there.

Mr. Dalley made a motion that  
rental money be turned into more  
new books instead of turning it  
to the treasurer. Mrs Knell sec. motion  
carried.

Oct 21 - 1936

Mrs. Knell made a motion the board authorize the secretary to give Mrs. Madson \$10.00 to help defray her expenss. see Mr Dalley. Carried.
