Jan 5-45 in City Safety Bldg. at 7 P.M.

Present were Mayor H. H. Hunt, Allie
Knell, Myrtle Jansen, Lee Allen G. O. Larsen
junior Librarian LaReta Riddle

Minutes and fin. report were given
and approved.

Mayor Hunt explained County fund
and ask Mr. Larsen to see County
Commissioners about transferring book
fund directly to Cedar Lib. Fund. Also
said there was to be a reorganizing
of County Board.

Mrs. Jansen brought up the question
