Mrs. Riddle presented her problems. She ask to have story hr. during the summer from 4 to 5 P.M. twice a week, also to have hobbies exhibited in library for a week before school began. She ask if she was expected to mend books.

After Mrs. Riddle had gone the board discussed her problems and by motion of G. O. Larsen 2nd by Wm Jones, Grace Mc Mullin was asked to convey the following decisions to her.

The Library Board appreciates her efforts in regard to the story hour but think it best to hold it between the hrs. of 2 to 3 or from 5 to 6 so as not to interfere with the high standard of service that now prevails in the library.

← In regard to the book mending the board is willing to allow some help from the employees now working, if this can be arranged with Mrs. Wise, But that with the recent \$20.00 raise in pay that she has been given the board expects her to do the job regardless of hrs.

Library Board meeting held in City and County Bldg. Aug. 8 - 1946. Present were Mayor Myron F. Higbee, Will Jones, G. O. Larsen, Allie Knell, Florence Covy - Grace McMillin and senior Librarian Margaret M. Wie. Mr. Larsen reported on interview with City Counsel on building inspection - said they were very receptive. They appointed the following committee, Ben Cooley, Bert Wood, Noroni Perry and G. O. Larsen to go over the building and see what repair ^{is} necessary.

Frank Cooley and Bryant Leigh were given the job of buttressing floor - fixing roof and building an outside chimney.

Mr. Larsen and W. S. Jones were authorized to ask the Junior Chamber if they would beautify the Pub. grounds.

Mr. Larsen ask to inform Miss Covy of the Board's decision. Mrs. Riddle a letter of appreciation. Mrs. Wie, Mrs. Knell and Florence Covy were chosen to present ^{Mrs.} Riddle with a gift - Ed Turner.
