Excerpt from Minutes of a Regular Session of the City Council
May 15, 1947.

The American Legion Committee, composed of Frank Dalley, Dick Leigh, Elias Leigh, met to report on the meeting regarding the American Legion Property.

The City's offer of \$10,000.00 was rejected, the American Legion ask \$15,000.00 for the property, but will settle for a smaller room in the building.

The Council agreed to consider the matter after consultation.

Councilman Roberts made the following motion:

That with the approval of the absent Councilman, we accept the American Legion Proposal submitted by Frank Dalley, Commander, for the purchase of property owned by the American Legion on Center and First West Street, approximately an 8 x 12 rod lot, for purchase price of \$15,000.00 and a room to be constructed on this site, with a minimum space of 800 square feet.

That the council consider this price for the lot at \$10,000.00 with \$5,000.00 as a donation for the Race Track.

Motion seconded by councilman Webster, Vote Unanimous.
