## Library Improvement To Be Shown At Open House

As a means of acquainting the general public with the improvements that have been made at the Carnegie public library in Cedar City, an open house will be held at the library from 6 to 10 p. m. on Friday, Aug. 15. During the open house attention will be called to the improved appearance due to the recent redecorating of the interior.

The Cedar City Garden club will have charge of arranging flowers in the library for this occasion and the flowers used will be on sale afterwards. Special displays of books will add to the interest of the evening.

Arrangements for the open house were completed at a meeting of the Library board held Friday, July 25. At the meeting the board, in looking forward to increased activities, laid plans to make requests of the local civic clubs for help in improvements to the library.

The board, under the chairmanship of William Jones, planned its work for the coming months, and assignments of responsibilities of board members were made. Present at the meeting were Mrs. Margaret M. Ute, librarian; Mrs. Edith Kirtley, librarian of the junior division; Mrs. Boyd Smith, who will work with Mrs. Kirtley in improving the junior library; Mrs. Grace McMullin, secretary; William Burton, publicity chairman, and Dr. Ead W. Farnsworth, who will work with Mrs. Dan Jones on the committee for the selection of adult books.

Mrs. Wie told of necessary supplies  
needed in library such as magazine to  
mending material, janitor supplies etc.

Mrs. Smith moved that library be closed  
on last day of Aug. so that custodian can  
complete work on floors - 2nd by Dr. Farnsworth  
motion carried.

In order that the public may see the newly decorated library, an open house is being planned for an evening in Aug. Mrs. Wile and Mrs. Kirtley were appointed as chairmans of same.

Mrs. Smith was asked to work with Junior Librarian in selecting books and otherwise improving this department.
