Two presents for Mrs. Urie were shown. The choice of the board was a mantel clock.

Mrs. Smith said those she had talked to about the Book Fair highly approved of it. She is to follow through with the project. Dr. Farnsworth is to interview Mr. Olds in regard to "Book Fair."

Dr. Farnsworth reported that Mrs. Dan Jones wished to resign from the board. It was decided to reccomend to the Mayor and Council the following names for a prospective board member:
