Minutes of meeting of Library Committee held in State President's office at 8 P.M.

Chairman J. S. Woodbury presiding

Committee on buildings reported having examined the City Hall, Tithing Office, Geo Woods old store and Hall Thenderson Bldg. The City Hall was, in their opinion the best suited for the purpose of Library and Gym.

Information of Mrs Knell this place was selected provided the City Council will consent to its use.

Moved by W. R. Palmer that John S. Woodbury investigate the matter of selecting an instructor for the Gymnasium. Carried.

Cedar Ut. Apr 21 09

Library Committee met in President's Office at 8 P.M. Present J. S. Woodbury.

Mrs Knell, John H. Walker and W. R. Palmer.

Library Committee submitted a list of books which they have selected.

Mr Woodbury reported having corresponded with Harold Wilkinson

relative to his coming and taking charge of the Gym. work.

It was suggested that it would be good to locate the library and Gym in close proximity to the District school and Committee on Building and Grounds were instructed to see the Ward Hall Committee about rooms.

Moved by J. H. Walker that we accept Mr. Wilkinson's proposition to conduct the Gym during the winter months for \$250.00 provided he can give us the work at the time we want it.

Mr. Woodbury was instructed to try and arrange a meeting with the School Trustees with a view to getting them to join us in the Gym work. Adjourned

J. H. Walker and Willard Carry. The School Trustees were also invited to be present and M. H. Dally was present to represent them. The matter of employing a teacher for the Gym. was again

Moved by W. H. Palmer that the matter of employing a Gym teacher be left entirely in the hands of Mr Woodbury. Carried.

An estimate of running expenses was made aggregating \$600<sup>00</sup> or \$700<sup>00</sup> if the Gym runs in during the summer.

Committee on buildings reported having inspected the Ward Hall. The two east rooms in the basement can be arranged for Gym. work and the Ward Hall Committee are willing to let us have the rooms rent free for one year.

Mayor Woodbury in charge.  
Mr Woodbury said he had seen Harold

Wilkinson relative to taking charge of  
 the Gym. Mr Wilkinson had come  
 to an understanding with the Normal  
 School as to hours and he can  
 give us several hours in the morning  
 and all the evenings. Having met  
 all of our requirements it was proposed  
 that we close our contract with him  
 and on motion of Willard Carry Mr  
 Woodbury was authorized to draw  
 up the necessary contracts and  
 with the secretary sign same  
 on behalf of the committee.

Committee on Furniture made a  
 partial report and the matter held  
 over for one week for more full  
 complete

Committee on Books also  
 made a partial report.
